Prof. K.N. Satyanarayana, Director, IIT Tirupati & President - IIC committee, welcomed the IIC committee members for the second IIC committee meeting. Subsequently, the president requested Prof. E. Anil Kumar, Dean R&D and Vice President / Convenor & Dr. K. Thiruppathi. Chief Manager — CSRC, IIT Tirupati and Start-up Activity Coordinator of IIC committee to present overall IIC activities carried out from the inception.

Prof. Anil Kumar & Dr. K. Thiruppathi made a detailed presentation about the IIC activities which includes the last IIC calendar activity (2021-22) and this year's (2022-23) Quarter-1 & II activities. Dr. K. Thiruppathi also briefly explained about the type of IIC activities and its weightage etc. (IIC Calendar activity, MIC-driven activity, Self-driven activity and Celebration activity) to the committee members.

Prof. K.N. Satyanarayana briefed about the IIT Tirupati team's participation in The IndUS Entrepreneurs (TiE) global summit held at Hyderabad from 12th to 14th December 2022 and thanked Mr. Suresh Raju (One of the organizing members for the TiE Global summit 2022 and expert member in IIT Tirupati IIC council) for sensitizing about the event and extending his support/connections for the same.

Dr. Thiruppathi briefed about the HC calendar (2022-23) quarter-I activities as listed below,

Our team gathered industry problem statements and started working out an innovative solution for the same).

Organized intra Institutional idea competition and rewarded the best ideas.

(In order to promote Innovation inside the campus a call for business ideas has been announced and received applications from 32 students and selected 4 teams subsequently sanctioned financial support up to 6.0 Lakhs to improve their TRL levels etc.)

Prof. K.N. Satyanarayana discussed with the student representatives about the impact of the preincubation initiatives. The student council members were briefed about the benefits and support provided by the Centre for Sponsored Research and Consultancy (CSRC) team to the president and the council members.
